Here are a number of photos from the spring and summer holidays. Notice the many children who participate and Father Pavel who has time for everyone who wants to talk to or be blessed by him.

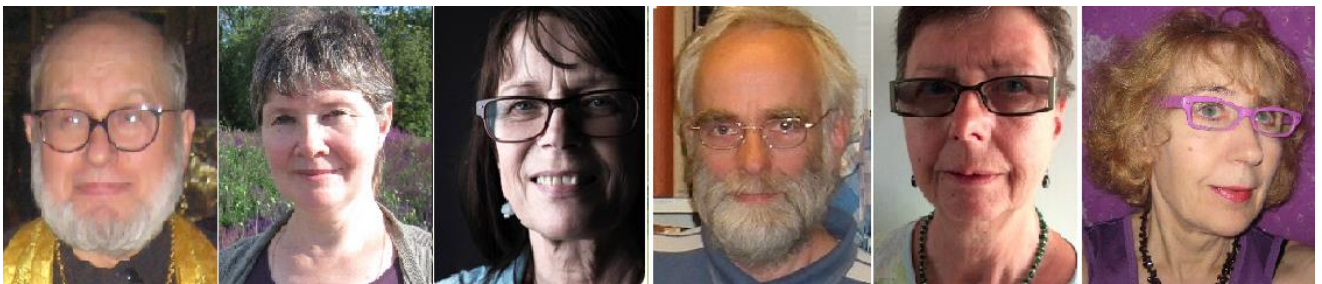


### *Christmas bazaar and donation*
