The past year in Moscow



Dear members of HumanCare Russia (the St. Apostle Paul Foundation!)

On the eve of the Bright Feast of Holy Easter, which all Christians celebrate this year on April 20, we want to wish you all joy in the Lord, strength, health, endless mercy of God and peace!

We always feel your love and care for our community with great gratitude.

In this letter we would like to share how we use the donations you have sent.

The past year has been very difficult for our community, which has several large families and many elderly people.

Father Pavel Vishnevsky has been appointed by the Primate of our parish by Metropolitan Alexander of Kazakhstan as the person responsible for social assistance. This is due to the fact that Father Pavel, like no one else, knows the needs and problems of the members of the parish of Saints Faith, Hope, Love and Sophia.

This year, on the feast of the Holy Trinity, it will be 25 years of his service in this church.

People turn to him with requests not only for his prayers, but also for material assistance, and Father Pavel tirelessly prays for everyone and each time rushes to help both the young and the old - to dress, shoe, feed, water, warm with paternal warmth and the wise word of a pastor.

Thanks to your financial assistance, we were able to send a large number of children's clothes and shoes to families with children.

Many necessary medications were sent to hospitals and hospices, where Father Pavel is well known, since he regularly visits those who are there.

A huge number of elderly people in need or simply people who have found themselves in difficult life circumstances were comforted by the caring word of Father Pavel. And such circumstances have been becoming more and more frequent lately. They are associated not only with illnesses, family problems or lack of work.

Many have become victims of scammers. A single mother with three teenagers, lost 2 million rubles under the influence of scammers; A couple lost their apartment. And these are just a few examples, there are many more such cases.



The life of our community is full not only of difficulties, but also of joys.

Our large families delight us with the successes and talents of their children.

At the church holiday in honor of the Nativity of Christ, Sunday school students showed a performance based on the Russian folk tale "Morozko" and also performed choral hymns.

Many children study in music schools.

Katya Menshikova's granddaughter Marfa, who lives with her parents in Cambridge, went with a choir to the USA in April, Irina Smirnova's grandsons, Yakov and Daniil Tikhonov study at a music

school in Yerevan. Galya Luzhetskaya's grandson entered a music college, he is studying to be a sound engineer.

Father Pavel visits large families: Feodora and Vladimir, who have 8 children. All are very smart, beautiful, creative.

He also helps young families with small children who have no relatives in Moscow, such as the family of Ilya and Ksenia from Kazakhstan. They have two children (4 and 3 years old), they rent an apartment, and although Ilya works as a fitness instructor, there is not enough money.

On Sundays, many children and their parents come to talk with Father Pavel, sometimes such conversations take place over a cup of tea.

Last year, Father Pavel baptized about 100 adults and more than 50 babies, including Dinara's newborn grandson. One of her 4 daughters married an actor from Brazil, he works in Moscow as a dance instructor.

Parents prefer that their children are baptized by Father Pavel, since the service is joyful and the babies do not cry. Father Pavel is also involved in the education of young people, both teenagers and students, and when they grow up, he continues to guide them in their spiritual life.



As you can see, he is very busy, age is also taking its toll, especially on his legs (he has grade 3 arthrosis in both knees). But despite this, he remains as joyful, sensitive and loving as ever.

With his blessing, we send you all our best wishes and gratitude.

Every time we receive material assistance from you, we remember Constance, who always remains with us, and the work to which she dedicated her life continues to unite us with you.

May the Lord bless you for many and blessed years!
